

QUALIFICATION TO MARRY

You are legally entitled to marry in a particular church if you live in its parish, or belong officially to that parish – ie you are on the parish's Electoral Roll. Other connections with the parish that entitle you to marry in one of its churches are:

1. Having been baptised in the parish, provided that the baptism did not form part of a combined service of Baptism and Confirmation;
2. Having had your Confirmation entered in the parish register;
3. Having had your usual place of residence in the parish for a period of at least six consecutive months.
4. Having habitually attended Public Worship in the parish for a period of at least six consecutive months.
5. Having had one's parent(s) have their usual place of residence in the parish for a period of at least six consecutive months during your lifetime.
6. Having had one's parent(s) habitually attend Public Worship in the parish for a period of at least six consecutive months during your lifetime.
7. Having had one's parents married in the parish.
8. Having had one's grandparents married in the parish.
