

THE CHEQS GROUP OF CHURCHES

QUALIFICATION TO MARRY

You are legally entitled to marry in a particular church if you live in its parish, or belong officially to it (ie are on its Electoral Roll). Other connexions with it can entitle you to marry there, as below.
